Baker Aviation Expands Maintenance Hangar Space in Addison, TX *Planning for 2013 Growth*

The Baker Aviation facility in Ft. Worth (KFTW) will accommodate Gulfstream aircraft and other long-range cabin aircraft for maintenance inspections and repair. One of the premier turbine jet repair stations at the Addison Airport, Baker Aviation is prepared to activate evening shifts as work timelines and customer demands dictate.
